YOUR VOTE MATTERS

ALLEGIANT STADIUM, THE LAS VEGAS BALLPARK, THE LAS VEGAS CONVENTION CENTER, AIRPORT PROJECTS, WATER AUTHORITY INFRASTRUCTURE, AND OTHER MAJOR PROJECTS ACROSS SOUTHERN NEVADA DID NOT HAPPEN BY ACCIDENT.

THEY HAPPENED BECAUSE WORKING PEOPLE ORGANIZED, STAYED ENGAGED, AND FOUGHT FOR ELECTED LEADERS WHO SUPPORT INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT, APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS, AND GOOD UNION JOBS.

THE PEOPLE ELECTED TO OFFICE DIRECTLY IMPACT:

- CONSTRUCTION JOBS
- WAGES AND BENEFITS
- RETIREMENT SECURITY
- WORKPLACE PROTECTIONS
- APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITIES

TOO OFTEN, WORKING PEOPLE ARE LEFT OUT OF DECISIONS THAT IMPACT OUR JOBS AND OUR FUTURE. NEVADA'S PRIMARY ELECTIONS ARE UNFORTUNATELY CONDUCTED BY POLITICAL PARTY, AND MANY WORKERS DO NOT REALIZE THEIR PARTY REGISTRATION DETERMINES WHICH CANDIDATES APPEAR ON THEIR BALLOT.

MANY OF THE UNION CANDIDATES ENDORSED BY THE SOUTHERN NEVADA BUILDING TRADES UNIONS ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY ELECTION. IF YOU WANT TO HELP ELECT LEADERS WHO WILL STAND WITH WORKING PEOPLE AND SUPPORT GOOD UNION JOBS, MAKE SURE YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION AND PARTY AFFILIATION ARE UPDATED BEFORE VOTING BEGINS.
